


# Supporting Reading in Year 1

Read a variety of fun, interesting and exciting books to promote a love for reading.




Don't forget to look at the SLS (School Library Service) website for ideal books for 5-7 year olds and SORA, where you can access many e-books and audiobooks.

As well as the days of the week, and numbers 0-9:



Children should be able to add these features to their writing:

- Add **prefixes** (un-) and **suffixes** (-s, -es, -ing, -ed, -er, -est) to words  
(*unfair, trees, benches, reading, waited, faster, fastest*)
- Join ideas together using **'and'**

*(the garden was huge and there were flowers)*

- **Adjectives** for description

*(the garden was huge and there were yellow flowers)*

- End sentences with a **full stop, question mark** or **exclamation mark**

*(Where did he come from? I loved the slide! They went for a quiet walk.)*
