Why Avon Tyrell?

- Educational Centre - Team building, Outdoor Pursuits and Environmental Studies.

- Independence.

Funding

- Total cost of trip = £270

Payment options- SCOPAY

- Payment in full
- Instalments
- 11th July £50 non refundable deposit
- Further 4 payments each of £55, during September, October, November and December.
- Final payment no later than 9th January

Packing

- Suggested packing list– minimum!
- Pack with child – ownership.
- Ensure practical clothing – warm, dry, protective.
- Label bag – name, school, home address.
- Label clothes and personal items.

Packing

Do...

- Mascot, book, pocket/travel games.
- Money - gifts (maximum £10) – named wallet/purse (label: name + school)
- Child responsible for belongings

Don't...

- Sweets, valuables – jewellery, iPod, computer game, camera, **mobile phone...**

Travelling

- Children informed of dormitory and activity groups on morning of departure.
- Coach to New Forest (50 mins)
- Children gather at school (timings tbc nearer the time).
- Travel sickness - Tablets, wrist bands etc.
Remember to pack a travel pill for return journey...



Arrival at Avon Tyrell

- Carry bags to dorm – building self contained.
- 2-10 children per room - bunk beds
- Meet Avon Tyrell leader and taken on tour of site.
- Fire drill.
- Unpack – Make beds (practise!)
- Ready for 1st activity...

Consent Forms

- See medical form sent via Parent Mail
- **NHS number**
- Medical info – Medicines will be held by designated teachers. Use more paper if necessary to write notes.
- **ENSURE** any medication is labelled with **child's name** and **correct dosage**.
- Centre has medical room with trained first aid staff.
- School Image consent – photos for school use
- Dietary requirements – these must be specific! (great choice - well catered for)...

Behaviour

Children will...

- Continue St. Peter's excellent reputation on public transport and at the centre
- Be respectful to staff, peers and children from other schools
- Be collected by parents if their behaviour spoils the experience for anyone else or puts themselves in danger e.g. repeatedly not following instructions...
