



ROAD SAFETY GUIDANCE for our CHILDREN and their CARERS

As our school children currently have a high focus on 'clean air' we thought this was a great opportunity to remind you of our road safety policies.

Traffic and road safety is a real concern for our school. Please think carefully about bringing your car into the school road and about the risks to your child's or other children's safety by being impatient. We have park and stride areas located short distances away from the school road. The guidance below has been designed to ensure safety. Please observe the following guidelines:

ROAD SAFETY GUIDELINES

- The legal speed limit in Oliver's Battery Road North (OBRN) is 20mph
- Zig-Zags **MUST** be kept clear for the safety of our children and emergency vehicle access. Please avoid parking opposite the zig-zags too!
- Single yellow or white lines indicate **NO** parking or waiting.
- Please think about others when parking in OBRN and consider '**Could a Fire Engine pass by if I park here?**' and '**Can a child cross the road safely if I park here?**'
- Please **NO IDLING** to help with **CLEAN AIR**.
- Reversing is unsafe around young children.
- The **ONLY** safe way to turn around in the school road is to use the turning area at the dead end of OBRN.
- The school drop off area (at the front entrance of the school) is for mornings only and the driver must stay in the car and move on slowly as soon as the children are safely out.
- The school drop off area is not to be used for any cars at the end of the school day.
- The school car park is only for **STAFF or DISABLED badge holders** who have specific permission from the school office.
- Residents Driveways are to be kept clear at **all times**.
- Please wait patiently in the queue to exit OBRN and avoid overtaking.

Please observe the following guidelines. Please note anyone breaking the law will be reported.
